MAP held its 13th Annual MAP Convention on 18th December 2012, which received an overwhelming response in terms of the number of people that participated in it. "Leadership, People and Innovation" was the theme of the convention.

The Keynote Macroeconomic Address was delivered by the renowned economist and former Vice President of the World Bank who travelled from Washington DC to be at the convention, **Mr. Shahid Javed Burki**. Other speakers included; South Asian Affair expert, **Dr. Marie Lall**, Head of Retail and Consumer Banking from Habib Bank, **Ms. Sima Kamil**, **Mr. Mike Sherman**, Head of Living Analytics and Group Digital Life at SingTel, who travelled from Singapore to be with us.

Mr. Furqan Qureshi, Senior Executive Vice President Business Zone South, PTCL, led a Panel Discussion, his panelists included Chairman of the Institute of Public Policy, Mr. Shahid Javed Burki, Founder and CEO, Pakistan Innovation Foundation; CEO Technomics International and Fellow, World Technology Network, Dr. Athar Osama, CEO, Gillette Pakistan, Saad Amanullah Khan and the head of innovative products and internal expansion at Bayt.com Muhammad Younas. We heard about the future of banking from the Former President and Chief Executive Officer of the Royal Bank of Scotland in Pakistan, Mr. Shehzad Naqvi. 
